



Our first project development in Scotland under our Scottish Distributor Mathers Dairy Utensils Ltd utilises 2 x Arbor ElectroGen 45 units with the heat being used to provide a chip drying function for a Biomass fuel supply business. Electricity is being used for powering this drying process as well as providing domestic power requirements and other general onsite farm uses. After all of these demands are satisfied there is still some power to sell onto the national grid through a guaranteed export tariff.

The project will enable the operator to dry woodchip with the lowest possible cost and therefore the business can offer high quality low moisture wood chips all year round whilst also earning an income from the renewable heat incentive - thereby supporting the investment costs.
